Playlist - a critical survey of song repertoire in Swedish schools

The forces shaping repertoire selection in Swedish compulsory music education today come from many sources inside and outside the classroom: from both students and teachers, central government directives, commercial interests, demographic shifts and current research in voice development. Because singing can be seen as such a fundamental aspect of music training for young children, much is at stake.

This doctoral study: Playlist – a critical survey of song repertoire in Swedish schools, is based on a nation-wide questionnaire survey of music teachers; it aims to describe current song repertoire and singing practices in Swedish compulsory school and to set these findings in an historical and music educational perspective.
